Primary Tasks

The primary responsibility of the Volunteer Invigilator is gallery invigilation. This role mainly involves being present in the galleries for the duration of their shift in order to protect the art works that are on display. Duties include answering any queries presented to the volunteer by our visitors and reporting any issues that may occur in the galleries that may need the attention of our gallery staff.

Volunteers working in the gallery spaces are critical to the visitor's positive experience at The Model. Key skills or personality attributes for this position are a willingness to engage with the public in a warm friendly and confident manner and excellent customer service is extremely important in this front-facing role.

Other optional roles available to our volunteers are helping at exhibition openings and other larger music & community events. This gives our volunteers a chance to experience some of the other interesting events that take place at The Model.

Time Commitment

Ideally, Volunteers would commit to a three-hour shift per week, scheduled to suit. Following receipt of your Application form, we will arrange an informal interview where we will discuss availability for the role and the applicant will be given a more in depth explanation of the volunteer's role.
